Local Accountability: School District Evaluation of Performance in Community and Student Engagement

Local Accountability (TEC 39.0545):

- Requires each district to evaluate the district's performance and the performance of each campus in the district on community and student engagement
- Requires every district to assign itself a rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable or unacceptable for both overall performance and each evaluation factor.
- Districts must submit rating to TEA and make publicly available August of each year
- Districts must use criteria developed by a local committee to evaluate the performance of the district and campus programs in the evaluation indicators
- Districts must create the local committee that will develop the criteria

The Purpose of Local Accountability:

- To evaluate community and student engagement
- Districts can showcase where they are excelling and where there is room for improvement
- To tell the story of what is happening in districts and on campuses when it's not a test day
- An opportunity to highlight community values, which are varied across the state and sometimes within a district

District Rubrics for Evaluation:

- Exemplary – Exceeds state or district expectations consistently; no revision to the program plan necessary
- Recognized – Meet or exceeds expectations but inconsistently – in most grades but not all, most programs but not all, most campuses but not all; minor revisions needed or increased monitoring of some strategies and goals
- Acceptable – Not all expectations met, but in compliance and some evidence of implementation; more major gaps than Recognized; major revisions to plan or monitoring of the plan necessary
- Unacceptable – Out of compliance, little to no evidence of implementation; new plan required
